WARRANTY - The laminate flooring has a warranty against fading, staining and waaring through. This warranty applies only to the original purchase, and proof of purchase must be retained for all claims. The warranty covers the registerment or refund of the product but does not include labor involved. Chips and scratches are not covered by the warranty (laminate may chip or scratch if a sharp object is dropped on it or diapped across it), warranty (laminate may went warp if excessive moisture gets into the boards), or bridging (occurs when insufficient expansion space was provided). Claims for these problems will not be considered. Claims for were must show a minium 1/2 inch diameter area. This warranty is pro-rated based on the amount of time the floor has been installed. For example, on the product having a 5 years warranty if you have a claim after 4 years we would refund or replace 20% of the laminate value.









Cleaning & Maintenance

Clean all liquid spills immediately. Simply dust mop or vacuum with a soft brush or wood-floor accessory to keep your floor clean from dust, dirt, or grit. A damp cloth or mop can be used without damage to the laminate panels, but do not use excessive water. Never spray water directly on to floor. Dry the floor throughly with a clean, soft cloth. Do not use soap based detergent, abrasive cleaner or combined "clean and shine" product on your laminate floor. Do not use steel wool or other sourcing pads that may scratch laminate panels. Do not wax or polish your laminate flooring. apply felt pads to furniture legs to avoid scratches. Save a few extra boards for the future to replace a damaged panel.
